Architecture and Design like none other

This one-of-a-kind cottage sits in a grove of cedars on a secluded 5 acre parcel. The architecture of the Anniversary Cottage reflects the traditional European style of a modified post and beam style architecture with authentic Portland stucco walls inside and out. There is no common lumber used in any of the outside walls. The realtor will be glad to show you a book detailing the construction of this masterpiece where art meets function. Exposed wooden beams, stone fireplace, a built-in stone pizza/ bread oven, and elegant furnishings create a cozy and inviting atmosphere. French doors open onto a fully finished 3

season room that then opens onto a stamped concrete veranda nestled in the trees. Inside doors are all custom made of oak to fit between the exposed beams. All floors are large old-world tile to give that look of something built centuries ago. The cottage is finished off with high pitched roofs and real cedar shake shingles. The high-end Pella doors and windows allow natural light to flood the interior, enhancing the sense of openness and connection to nature. The cottage features a quant living area, a fully equipped kitchen with cherry wood cabinets and an ensuite bedroom all with high pitched vaulted cedar ceilings to complement the inside stucco walls.
